## JOURNEY TIMES & GENERAL INFORMATION

Single journey time approx. 30 minutes. Return journey time: starting at **Llanuwchllyn** 1hr 10 min approx.; starting at **Bala** 1hr 30 min to 1hr 45 min to allow for engines taking on coal and water.

Whilst Covid restrictions apply it is only possible to start and finish your journey at Llanuwchllyn and Bala. Intermediate stops at Llangower and Pentrepiod are closed.

Once re-opened, trains will call at Llangower as shown in the timetables. Trains will also stop at Pentrepiod Halt approx. 5 mins after departure from Llanuwchllyn and approx. 5 mins after departure from Llangower for trains starting at Bala. To join the train please signal clearly to the driver. To alight, inform the guard prior to boarding the train.

**NOTE: All trains finish their day's work at Llanuwchllyn; It is therefore not possible to make a return trip with the last departure from Bala.**

Whilst every care will be taken to ensure that trains run as advertised the Company reserve the right to vary the published timetable and to alter, cancel or suspend any train without notice and accept no liability for any loss, delay or inconvenience thereby caused.

**CAFE & FREE PARKING** at Llanuwchllyn. There is only roadside parking and a shelter at Bala Station.
