## JOURNEY TIMES & GENERAL INFORMATION

Single journey time approx. 30 minutes. Return journey time: starting at **Llanuwchllyn** 1hr 10 min approx.; starting at **Bala** 1hr 30 min to 1hr 45 min to allow for engines taking on coal and water.

Trains call at Llangower as shown in the timetable, and at Pentrepiod halt approx. 5 minutes after departing Llanuwchllyn or approx. 5 minutes after departing Llangower (for trains starting from Bala). Tickets from intermediate stations must be booked online (this can be done up to time of departure, subject to availability of seats) and passengers intending to join the train must give a clear signal to the driver.

Passengers wishing to break their journey at an intermediate station and continue onward by a later train must purchase two separate tickets to/from the intermediate station, ensuring that the return legs of their journey correspond.

**NOTE: All trains finish their day's work at Llanuwchllyn; It is therefore not possible to make a return trip with the last departure from Bala.**

Whilst every care will be taken to ensure that trains run as advertised the Company reserve the right to vary the published timetable and to alter, cancel or suspend any train without notice and accept no liability for any loss, delay or inconvenience thereby caused.

**CAFE & FREE PARKING** at Llanuwchllyn. There is only roadside parking and a shelter at Bala Station.

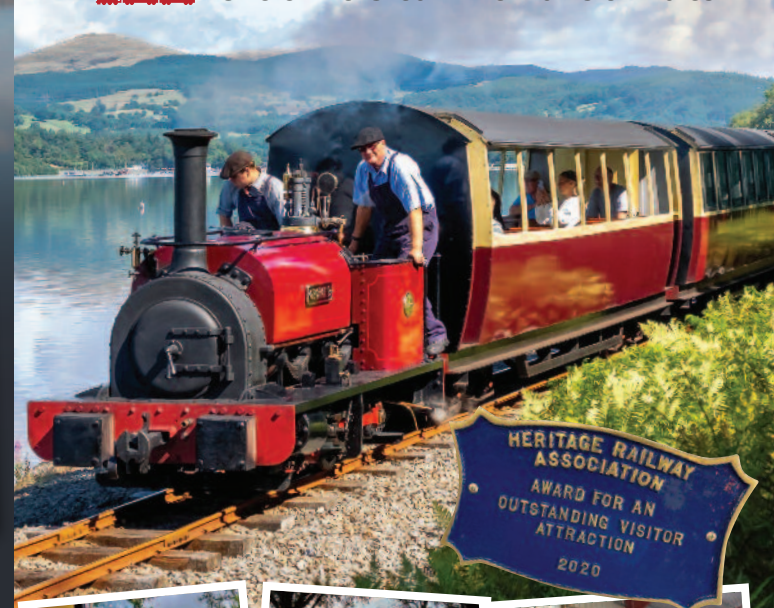
